The North Glengarry Prescott & Russell Transport Board confirmed today its planned excursions to the **Glengarry Highland Games in Maxville on Saturday July 31st** next between Ottawa and Maxville and Montréal and Maxville. These excursions are offered to help reduce automobile congestion and pollution, reduce parking problems and allow Games-goers to take part in all activities in complete safety.

This year the Commission was confronted with a large increase in the cost of train transport, so it decided to change the mode of travel to the air-conditioned, washroom equipped motor coaches offered by its partner 417 Bus Lines.

Departures to Maxville will be at 9:30 am from West-end Ottawa and 10 am from the east end; from Centre-town Montréal at 9:30 am and from Pointe Claire at 9:50 am, with returns in the evening **after** the Massed Bands event. Parking in Ottawa and Pointe Clair will be free and fares for the bus rides will be modest: \$25 from Ottawa and \$35 from Montréal and Pointe Claire. Admission to the Games costs \$20 but children under 12 enter free.

In Ottawa tickets may be purchased at the Scottish and Irish Stores at 194 Robertson Rd in the west and 1713 St-Laurent Boulevard in the east; purchase may also be effected by phone.*

In Montréal one may get tickets at Bramble House at 57 N Donnegani Ave. Pointe Claire or by phone**.

The Trains to the Games were very popular, and the organizers call on Games-goers to use our service in good number this in our comfortable motor coaches.
